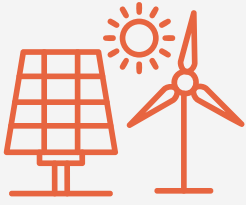


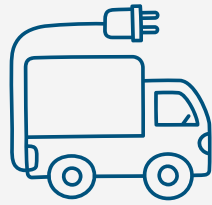
2023 Highlights

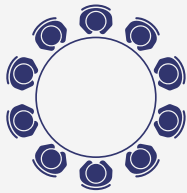

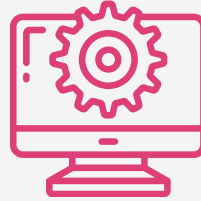
